Overview

This document has been prepared to support the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2024/3005 on ESG Rating Activities (the “EU ESG Rating Regulation” or the “Regulation”). Within the ISS STOXX group, Institutional Shareholder Services Germany AG is currently intended to apply to the European Securities and Markets Authority (“ESMA”) in relation to relevant ESG rating activities in the Union.

The solutions listed below are those Sustainability Solutions that Institutional Shareholder Services Germany AG issues, publishes or distributes within the meaning of Article 3(1), 3(2) or 3(3) of the EU ESG Rating Regulation (the “Regulated Sustainability Solutions”).

Only such Regulated Sustainability Solutions fall within the scope of the Regulation. The identification of Regulated Sustainability Solutions is based on the definition and criteria set out in the Regulation. For those products that are in scope, the applicable transparency requirements apply, including the public disclosure of methodologies (Article 23 and Annex III (1)).
